PROPOSED 2023-2024 COMMON AND UNIVERSITY / PROGRAM SPECIFIC FEES

<u>Action Requested</u>: Consider the proposed changes to Common and University / Program Specific Fees for the 2023-2024 academic year as highlighted in blue in the spreadsheets on pages 2-6. Justifications may be found on pages 7-12.

Executive Summary: Common and University / Program Specific Fees are assessed only to students that use these services based on their programs, interests, or needs. Students may pay one or more fees as presented in this memorandum for the direct costs associated with using additional miscellaneous services provided by the universities. These fees are separate from tuition and mandatory fees.

Final Board approval is required prior to implementation of the fee changes. Board action on these fees is scheduled at the next meeting. Adoption of these fees is subject to revision at a later date if cost recovery is different than the original estimate.

Background:

<u>Board Policy Manual</u> §1.6H: (1) requires the Board to review and approve all new institutional or college-wide fees over \$1 per semester and all departmental fees over \$10 per semester; and (2) encourages the three universities to work together to establish common titles and amounts for fees. Some differences in fee titles and amounts may remain because of the unique nature of some programs and services at each institution.

<u>lowa Code</u> §262.9(19) requires the Board to take action no sooner than 30 days after notification of the proposed fee changes to presiding officers of each student government organization at each affected institution. Written notification of the proposed fee changes will be sent to the student government presidents at each of the universities.

This fee continues to be a one-time assessment that replaced individual fees for registration changes (add/drop), transcripts, degree applications, and duplicate diplomas.

Board Policy Manual §1.6H encourages the three universities to work together to establish common titles and amounts for fees. This year, all three institutions are requesting an increase to \$250. This fee has not increased since first assessed in FY 2017.

<u>*Rationale*</u>: To be replaced by the "Graduate Publication Fees – Masters/Doctorate" (see above) which will be charged to all graduate students across the board. Currently, UNI only charges Thesis Fees to students completing theses/dissertations. The majority of UNI's Master's students pursue a non-thesis track and are not charged any fees yet they use Graduate College review and editing services.

Due to the increased number of programs in Physician Assistant education, many students are submitting the first deposit, and then very late into the season, but before the 2nd deadline, are declining the initial offer. The program is losing many qualified candidates that could have been selected from the alternate list had the initial candidate not changed their mind so late in the process.

College of Education UI REACH Program

<u>*Rationale*</u>: To keep up with increasing costs, meet student needs, and enable the Realizing Educational and Career Hopes (REACH) program to expand services to students.

The goal is to ensure the program has adequate financial support to cover program costs while keeping REACH as affordable as possible.

Annual Program Fees provide the necessary financial support for an essentially self-sufficient REACH program and cover the following: personnel, operations, curriculum and program development, marketing, program evaluation and REACH course instruction expenses. Its budget also includes expenses associated with internship development, web-based and on-site post-program follow-up activities, and support of the student alumni group.

A critical component of this program is developing relationships with families and students across time and maintaining a low student to instructor ratio to provide the support needed for student success.

REACH is approved as a Comprehensive Transition Program by the Department of Education, allowing REACH students to apply for federal Pell grants, thus making the REACH program more affordable. Further, through the generosity of donors, REACH is able to offer partial scholarships to students with financial need.

The REACH Program is a unique transition certificate program for college students with disabilities, such as autism, intellectual disabilities, and learning disabilities. REACH empowers young adults to become independent members of the community. Coursework, campus life and career experiences prepare students to reach their full potential.

Students can enroll in the program for up to four years with early graduation options after year two. Students live in university housing, take a full course load, further develop independent living skills, and work at a variety of community internships.

Quality programming and the required support for students with complex disabilities necessitates a skilled staff, which the program maintains at a staff to student ratio of less than 1:3. REACH employs approximately 26 undergraduate student mentors to assist with classroom support and campus life. The program employs student Resident Assistants (RAs) and two evening staff for the two-year program to support REACH students in the residence halls so that access to staff is available 24/7.
