REPORT OF CAMPUS SAFETY AND SECURITY SUB-COMMITTEE

Action Requested: Receive the Campus Safety and Security Sub-Committee Report.

Executive Summary: Campus safety and security is a responsibility that is of critical importance to the Board of Regents. Campus safety and security efforts reflect best practices for responding to sexual violence and harassment and reporting of on-campus crime. It includes required training to help identify and prevent sexual violence, harassment, and other misconduct as well as identifying and training institution staff responsible for enforcing and investigating alleged Title IX violations.

The purpose of the Sub-Committee is to (1) monitor and review campus safety and security reports; and (2) monitor and review campus safety and security issues as appropriate. The membership of the Sub-Committee includes Chair Regent Sherry Bates, Vice Chair Regent Rachael Johnson, Chief Diversity Officer & Associate Vice President Georgina Dodge (SUI), Assistant Vice President & Chief of Police Jerry Stewart (ISU), Vice President of Student Affairs Terry Hogan (UNI), and Assistant Administrator John Cool (ISD). The Sub-Committee reports to the Education and Student Affairs Committee.
