Background:

Battelle report The Battelle report, <u>lowa's Bioscience Pathway for Development</u>, included a recommendation for the formation of an lowa Biosciences Alliance whose purpose would be to facilitate communications, foster joint approaches to issues, and develop a critical mass of support to stimulate actions required to realize lowa's bioscience vision.
