#### ICCPHSE Meeting Minutes – Wednesday, April 16, 2014

The Iowa Coordinating Council for Post-High School Education (ICCPHSE) met on Wednesday, April 16, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. at the IACCT Office. Chair Dan Kinney welcomed the council members and guests to the meeting.

#### 3. Presentation: Iowa Core and Smarter Balanced Assessment - Diana Gonzalez

A panel presented an overview of the Iowa Core standards and implementation and Smarter Balanced Assessment efforts. The panel included: Judith Spitzli, Mathematics Consultant, Iowa Department of Education; Colleen Anderson, Digital Library, Iowa Department of Education; and Robert Stein, Smarter Balanced Regional Consultant.

One central component of a great school system is a clear set of expectations, or standards, that educators help all students reach. In lowa, that effort is known as the lowa Core. The lowa Core represents statewide academic standards, which describe what students should know and be able to do in math, science, English language arts and social studies. The lowa Core also addresses 21st century skills in areas such as financial and technology literacy. These state standards provide lowa students, parents, teachers, and other stakeholders with a clear, common understanding of what students are expected to learn at every grade level, regardless of where they live. The standards establish what lowa students need to learn, but not how to teach. Local schools and teachers continue to create lesson plans and tailor instruction to fit the needs of their students. The standards are, in most cases, more rigorous.

A second central component is assessment of what is taught, tied to standards. Iowa joined the Smarter Balanced Assessment Consortium, one of two multistate assessment consortia working to develop an assessment system aligned with common core standards. Stein provided an overview of consortium governance, the need for faculty involvement, field testing of the assessment, and more. Other efforts supporting this work include expanded formative assessment and the implementation of a digital library of resources for teachers.

#### 8. M-State Authorization Reciprocity Agreement (SARA) Update from the ICSAC - Julie Leeper

The state authorization bill was passed by the Governor and will be ready for implementation on July 1, 2014. There was discussion about the process for registering lowa higher education institutions and how the reciprocity process will work. The registration cost is not yet finalized. Approximately 24 states are expected to move forward with state authorization reciprocity legislation this year with more expected next year.

Dear (President):

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself as the Chair of the Iowa Coordinating Council for Post-High School Education for 2014-2015 and to share some of my thoughts about the work of the Iowa Coordinating Council.

The lowa Coordinating Council membership includes all lowa post-secondary institutions. Its main function is "to provide an effective means for voluntary cooperation and coordination among the various boards which are ultimately responsible for post-high school education in lowa." One of the Coordinating Council's principal responsibilities is to "provide for review of all proposals for new academic programs, including on-line programs, and the offering of existing programs at new locations."

To accomplish that responsibility, the Iowa Coordinating Council uses a process which requires the preparation and submission of an Intent to Offer Form. All proposals to offer **new academic programs and/or new locations** are submitted to the Iowa Coordinating Council <u>listserv</u> to give members an opportunity to review and comment on the proposal(s). The listserv is our key communication tool. This process allows member institutions to engage in collegial discussions about the higher education needs of the state.

A second responsibility is the **annual ICCPHSE enrollment report** which is an important statewide data gathering effort. The electronic survey which we use has definitely streamlined the process. The survey will be sent to your institutional IPEDS coordinator/registrar at the beginning of October. I urge you to ensure that the enrollment survey is completed on a timely basis. The enrollment information is used by a number of state agencies, including the Legislative Services Agency, so 100% participation in the survey is critical. **Please be aware that last year's survey respondent for your institution will be notified when the survey is available for completion**. If this person is no longer applicable, please notify Diana Gonzalez at your earliest convenience.

The Coordinating Council Executive Committee has developed the meeting schedule for the 2014-2015 academic year. During this academic year, we will have two face-to-face meetings — October 7, 2014 at the University of Northern Iowa (Cedar Falls) and April 15, 2015 at Drake University (Des Moines). Our January meeting on January 21, 2015 will be scheduled as a conference call as-needed and the agenda will include only time-sensitive business items. We will continue our practice of having informative presentations at the meetings and anticipate worthwhile interactions with member representatives at the meetings.

I look forward to working with all of you during the coming year on meeting the goals of the lowa Coordinating Council. I am confident that we can continue to work collaboratively to provide quality educational services to the citizens of lowa.
