Executive Summary:

Proposed Calendar In accordance with Board of Regents Policy Manual §6.12, the Board is asked to approve the calendars for 2005-06 and 2006-07 for the academic years and summer sessions at Iowa State University.


Each fall and spring semester includes 74 class days. The summer sessions each include two eight-week sessions. The first session is intended primarily for continuing students. The second summer session is intended for new students direct from high school and for courses appealing to elementary and secondary school personnel.

The University Calendar Committee, composed of representatives of faculty, staff, and students, developed the proposed calendars.

No major changes There are no major changes in the calendar structure for the proposed calendars.

Force Formed

A task force, recently named by President Geoffroy, will examine university calendar issues. If the work of this task force should lead to a request to change the 2005-07 calendars, the proposal would be submitted to the Board of Regents for approval.
