### Recommended Action:

Approve the University of Iowa request to suspend the graduate admissions to the M.A. degree in Russian language and literature.

### Executive Summary:

- The University of Iowa requests permission to suspend the graduate admissions to the M.A. degree in Russian language and literature.
- Board policy (*Procedural Guide* §6.20) requires Board approval prior to the suspension of a program.

#### Analysis:

Procedural Guide §6.20, Policy on Academic Program Termination and Reduced Admissions, states: "If an institution wishes to limit, suspend, or substantially reduce admission to a program, it should provide that information to the Board in advance of the implementation of the reduction and report back to the Board its intentions with respect to the program."

## Proposed Procedures

- The University intends to suspend graduate admissions to the M.A. degree in Russian language, effective immediately.
- The University will review the suspension in 18-24 months after the program has been reassessed and the impact on potential M.A. students of Russian have been evaluated.
- SUI will inform the Board of further intentions after the reassessment.
